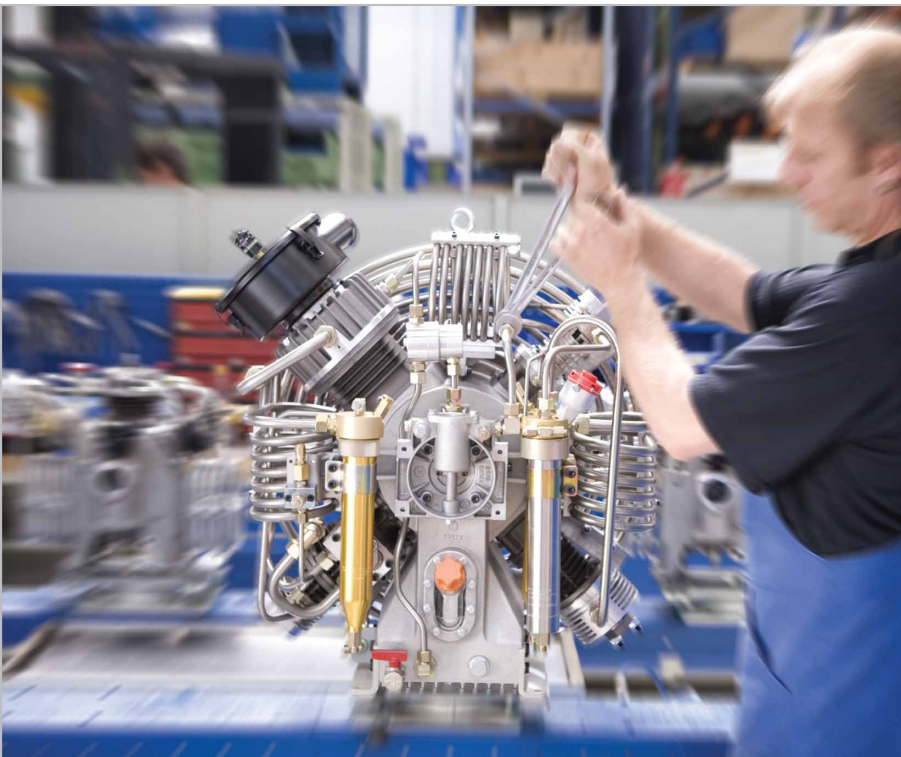

SERVICE AND REPAIR

Pre-registration is required as seating is limited. To reserve a seat, each student must submit the pre-registration form with a non-refundable deposit of 50% of cost (check or credit card only). The balance must be paid in full prior to the start of the chosen session. The session will be considered full when (15) applications and corresponding deposit(s) have been received (minimum 6 - maximum 15).

All fees are non-refundable. If a cancellation is received (15) days before the start of the scheduled session, applicant

will be given credit to attend a future session (subject to availability) for up to 12 months from date of original course date. If cancellation is less than (10) days of the scheduled session, applicant will forfeit tuition paid.

Student seats/tuition are non-transferrable without prior approval from BAUER COMPRESSORS INC. Transfer can only be accepted in writing a minimum (15) days before course begins. Any non-approved transfers will result in seat and tuition forfeiture by original student. Student must

wear appropriate shop attire (i.e. closed toe shoes); failure to comply will be grounds for dismissal from course with tuition forfeiture.

The cost covers the tuition, as well as study materials and workshop manuals, which are retained by the students. Accommodations and travel are the responsibility of the student or their sponsor. A certificate of completion is awarded to each student at the conclusion of the session. (This is not a factory certification.) Certificate can be reissued up to one year after course completion.
